- Comply with legal obligations.

The Inquisit Business Publications collects only the minimum information necessary to provide services and process requests. Providing this information is voluntary; however, it may be required to complete certain transactions or requests. Alternative service methods, such as phone or in-person service, may be available.

Inquisit Business Publications does not sell, trade, or rent personal information. Inquisit Business Publications only shares information with third-party service providers who perform necessary business functions, having a right-to-know, and only as Inquisit Business Publications deem necessary.
